In both the *Globe & Mail* and *Maclean's Magazine*, The University of Winnipeg ranks in the Top-10 on an annual basis as one of Canada's leading post-secondary institutions according to our students. This year The University of Winnipeg Foundation unveiled an ambitious Capital Campaign with a target of \$70-million. The University has created "A World of Opportunity", which has so far raised an inspiring \$58-million. The expansion of Duckworth Centre, the enhancement of public access to Spence Street is completed. The refurbishment of Wesley Hall, the construction of the Richardson College for the Environment & Science complex and the McFeetors Hall: Great-West Life Student residence are underway. #### John Langstaff, B.Sc., Ph.D Honorary Doctor of Science

John Langstaff is an individual who is actively committed to the development of science and to the advancement of the healthcare industry in Canada.

Langstaff, a 2001 Distinguished Alumnus of The University of Winnipeg, is an international leader in pharmaceutical research and development. The President & CEO of Cangene Corporation, Langstaff has been influential in developing excellence in the biotechnology industry in Manitoba.

Under Langstaff's leadership, Cangene has become a world leader in the development, manufacture and commercialization of specialty hyperimmune plasma and biotechnology products. These antibody products may aid in the fight against challenging diseases such as Hepatitis B, smallpox, Ebola, anthrax and SARS.

His direction has led to Cangene being recognized as one of Canada's best employers, one of Canada's fastest growing companies and one of the world's Top-100 biotechnology companies. His industry contributions outside of Cangene are also significant. A present member of the Board of Directors for Biotec Canada and the University of North Dakota Research Foundation, Langstaff has also served as a



member of the Board of Directors for the International Centre for Disease Control and the chairman of Bionet – an Industry Development Initiative of the Government of Canada.

Today, The University of Winnipeg is honoured to present John Langstaff with an Honorary Doctor of Science for his long, remarkable career in science and healthcare.

#### Sharon Hope Irwin, B.A., M.A., Ed.D Honorary Doctor of Laws

For more than 25 years Irwin has dedicated her efforts to children with special needs. The founding director of SpeciaLink – the National Centre for Child Care Inclusion, Irwin has served on numerous commissions, working groups, task forces and committees with the purpose of disseminating successful inclusive child care practices and policies.

She is an advocate for young children with special needs and their families, locally, regionally and nationally, serving on numerous commissions, working groups, task forces and committees.

As Senior Researcher of SpeciaLink, the National Centre for Child Care Inclusion, her work took her across Canada, identifying, analyzing and disseminating successful inclusive practices and policies in child care.

Her work for the special needs project of the Canadian Union of Postal Workers helped to add a labour partner to the growing movement for equitable treatment of children with special needs and their families. Among her many publications, Irwin is the primary author of the SpeciaLink Child Care Inclusion Scales, a tool for measuring inclusion and for helping centres work towards higher inclusion quality. Irwin has provided training in these Inclusion Scales to



more than 2,500 child care staff and related professionals across Canada and the United States, often in collaboration with Debra Mayer of Winnipeg, the current director of SpeciaLink.

Today, The University of Winnipeg is honoured to present Sharon Hope Irwin with an Honorary Doctor of Laws for her outstanding work in the area of inclusive child care and early intervention programs.



#### Mohinder Singh Dhillon, B.A. (Hons.) Honorary Doctor of Laws

Mohinder Singh Dhillon is an entrepreneur and wellrespected leader in Manitoba's Indo-Canadian community. Throughout his life, he has championed diversity and multiculturalism. He is an ardent advocate for human rights and is devoted to supporting Manitoba's new immigrants.

"Mohinder is an excellent role model for our community," said President & Vice Chancellor Dr. Lloyd Axworthy. " He illustrates the ideals of leadership, engaged citizenship and service that we wish to instill in our students and which express the values of our University."

Dhillon arrived in Winnipeg in 1967, Canada's Centennial Year, and has been contributing to the fabric of his community ever since. As a new immigrant, he was familiar with the challenges that many new Canadians face upon their arrival in Manitoba while raising a family.

Upon his arrival, he worked full-time at Bristol Aerospace. Today, he leads his own real estate company R & R Realty, which he currently operates while making a contribution to his community.

Dhillon's work with the Manitoba Interfaith Immigration Council has helped welcome and integrate close to 5,000 refugees and new immigrants to our province.



Dhillon has contributed his time and effort to more than 30 organizations including his serving as an advisory board for the Canadian Museum for Human Rights and The University of Winnipeg's Global College.

#### James A. Richardson, B.A. Honorary Doctor of Laws

James A. Richardson is the great-grandson and namesake of the founder of James A. Richardson & Sons, Limited, a company that has contributed to Canada's growth since 1857. Richardson not only inherited his grandfather's name, he also inherited his grandfather's leadership skills and the family spirit of philanthropy. Richardson is renowned for his business acumen and tireless commitment to our community.

Richardson attended The University of Winnipeg Collegiate before obtaining a BA from Queen's University and launching his career at James A. Richardson & Sons, Limited.

Richardson's vision and practice of philanthropy is 'get involved', which he demonstrated at an early age.

For decades Richardson, has been at the forefront of community service, serving diverse organizations such as the Canadian Paraplegic Association, Big Brothers Big Sisters and the Canadian Olympic Foundation. #### **Claudia A. Wright, AB, MA, PhD** Fellowship in United College

Claudia Wright has been instrumental in the creation of two critically important new programs at The University of Winnipeg – the Aboriginal Governance program and the Urban and Inner-City Studies program.

At her retirement in July 2007, Wright was Vice-President, Research and Graduate Studies, having served the University for more than 38 years. With the same dedication, Wright has served the wider community, most notably in her commitment to human rights and multiculturalism.

From 1984 to 1988, Wright served as Chairperson of the Manitoba Human Rights Commission, and was instrumental in introducing a new human rights code for Manitoba. She also co-chaired the provincial Manitoba Task Force on Multiculturalism, was Vice-President of the Canadian Association of Statutory Human Rights Agencies and served on the Mayor's Advisory Committee on Race Relations for the City of Winnipeg. In each of these roles she brought credit and distinction to The University of Winnipeg and was honoured with numerous awards including: The Clarence Atchison Award for Community Service (1985); the National Black Coalition of Canada Distinguished Service Award for Political Action and Education in the



Community (1983-84); the YWCA Woman of the Year Award for Public Affairs (1985).

Before joining the senior executive team at The University of Winnipeg, Wright was the Dean of Social Science and an active member of the Faculty Association.

Claudia Wright's admission to Fellowship in United College recognizes four decades of untiring public service to both The University of Winnipeg and the broader community.

### Earl. E. Backman, B. Sc. Distinguished Alumni Award

Earl Backman (B.Sc.'68) was born and raised on a dairy farm in Lundar, Manitoba in the Interlake Region 75 miles north of Winnipeg. The ninth of nine children, he attended high school in Lundar and Warren, Manitoba. He and his future wife Candace initially studied at United College. Both graduated with Bachelor of Science degrees from the newly chartered University of Winnipeg in 1968.

Backman recently retired after 35 years of public service in Manitoba. In February 1997, he became Chief Executive Officer of the Brandon Regional Health Authority, which was the only fully integrated Health Services Region in the province, having responsibility for delivery of a full spectrum of health care services directly to Brandon, and regionally to 180,000 people in Western Manitoba. Backman had previously served as city manager of the City of Brandon for 14 years, where he was responsible for all traditional city operations, the Municipal Airport and Fire/Emergency/Ambulance Services.

Earlier in his career, he spent 14 years (1969-1983) with the Government of Manitoba, including positions in the Departments of Public Health; Health and Social Development; Management Committee of Cabinet (Treasury Board); Education and The Public Schools Finance Board. Backman has always been active in community life. While working and raising a family for 25 years in the Winnipeg area, he served as the youngest board member of the Misericordia Hospital and also was elected its youngest Chair of the Board. He has maintained a close interest in the hospital's operations over the years, participating as an originating member of the Misericordia Hospital Foundation.



During 20 years in Brandon, Backman was

also very actively involved with a number of organizations, including the Chamber of Commerce, the Brandon Economic Development Board, Venture Corporation, Wheat Belt Community Futures, the Keystone Centre, the Downtown Business Improvement District and the Assiniboine Riverbank Development Board. He also coached youth hockey and baseball teams.

Backman served as Chair of the successful 1997 Canada Summer Games Bid Committee and Chair of the Board of Governors of the Host Society for those highly successful Games.

An avid golfer and baseball player, Backman continues to volunteer and participate in a variety of sporting activities.



#### Athar Ata, B.Sc., M.Sc., PhD The Clifford J. Robson Memorial Award for Excellence in Teaching

Athar Ata is an associate professor of chemistry at The University of Winnipeg, renowned for his energy and enthusiasm. Ata has an excellent reputation as a teacher that is exemplified in his full classes, especially for nonrequired courses.

Associate Professor and Acting Chair of Chemistry Désirée Vanderwel describes Ata as "the anchor of the chemistry program" at The University of Winnipeg. He has trained and mentored numerous students in his labs who have continued their academic success in research, published work and awards.

He is a consummate researcher who shares his knowledge. Ata's labs are known to engage, motivate and educate future chemists while instilling the highest research standards. Ata serves as an excellent role model for his students. The Clifford J. Robson Memorial Award for Excellence in Teaching is earned by gaining the respect, support, admiration and recognition of students. In particular, her passion for science education has led to several high-profile science outreach programs. Let's Talk Science is a program where University faculty and students visit area schools or host field trips to the University to promote science awareness and literacy, in a hands-on manner.

Milosevic-Zdjelar is one of the main coordinators for UWinnipeg's participation in the NSERC Promoscience Program – a program that features a series of weekly science activities at the Manitoba Children's Museum.

Milosevic-Zdjelar has also helped with the CSI program of summer camps for inner-city schools that is run through the Social Planning Council of Winnipeg. The program helps at-risk elementary students stay involved in learning over the summer months.

She assists with the organization of the Homework Club at the Wii Chiiwaakanak Learning Centre, presents at conferences and



symposia for science teachers, judges science fairs, serves as a mentor to numerous teachers and students, and speaks to several outside organizations – all while maintaining a heavy teaching load at the University.



## The University of Winnipeg Coat of Arms

The Coat of Arms of The University of Winnipeg was officially adopted by the governing bodies of the University during the academic session of 1972-73.

The elements found within the Coat of Arms have been associated over the years with both Manitoba and Wesley Colleges, the ancestors of United College. The bunch of grapes in the lower portion of the inner shield derives from the Coat of Arms of Manitoba College. The grape symbol has its origin in the College seal adopted in the charter of 1871. The cross, the lamp, and the open book derive from the Coat of Arms of Wesley College, designed in 1897 by Dr. J.H. Riddell. The cross, the symbol of sacrificial service in the interest of humanity, was the basis for his design and upon it he placed a shield, the symbol of protection. The lamp, the symbol of light, also represents learning, to which the Colleges have been devoted to for over a century in the Province of Manitoba. The open book, representing instruction in the way of life and the bringing of understanding to the student, symbolizes knowledge in a general sense, although it may carry overtones of the Holy Scriptures in a more limited interpretation.

The motto, placed upon a scroll below, is the United College motto, her retained: Lux et Veritas Floreant (Let Light and Truth Flourish). The words catch the central import of the lamp (light) and the open book (truth), and express the hope that both may flourish (as the grape) in our country (the cross).



# Academic Dress

Academic dress originated in medieval times to provide warmth in the damp halls of learning. In its present form it includes a gown, hood (worn over the shoulders), and a cap or mortarboard. All universities have distinctive dress for each degree offered which explains the variety seen in the academic procession.

University of Winnipeg academic dress conforms to the North American Intercollegiate Code. All graduates wear a black gown which varies according to the degree conferred. The bachelor's gown is worn closed in front and is distinguished by its pointed sleeves. The master's gown is designed to be worn either open or closed in front and has closed sleeves with an opening to free the hands. The front portion of the sleeve below the opening has a long semi-circular cut-out. Doctorate gowns also may be worn open or closed. They are faced with velvet.

The edging colour on the hood indicates the faculty in which a degree is conferred: Theology – red; Science – gold; Education – blue; Arts – white. The width of edging is determined by the degree: three inches for doctors; two inches for masters and bachelors. Hoods are lined in red with a white chevron.

Honorary doctors' gowns are red in colour and are faced with white velvet. They are worn with red Tudor bonnets. The hood colour signifies the honorary degree: white for Laws; golden yellow for Science; admiralty blue for Letters; purple for Divinity. Hoods are lined in red and white, The University of Winnipeg colours. Fellows wear a gown of blue with neither hat nor hood. Members of the University's senior administration wear gowns of varying colours. They do not wear hoods.

### The Banner

The banner, prominently displaying the Coat of Arms, was unveiled in 1988. The volunteer effort of Pat Corner, Fran Farquhar, Susan Ferguson, and Sonya C. Wright took more than 1,000 hours. Over 400 meters of thread and 30 meters of wool material went into the project using traditional techniques such as quilting, embroidery, and crewel.
