AWARD DESCRIPTION:

This prize was established in honour of Associate Professor Douglas Skoog, faculty member of the Sociology Department and Coordinator of the Studies in Justice and Law Enforcement Program at The University of Winnipeg. **It will be awarded to an outstanding student in Criminal Justice Studies who has completed at least 60 credit hours and has demonstrated community involvement (preferably criminal justice related).**

SELECTION CRITERIA

LEVEL OF AWARD: Undergraduate, minimum 60 credit hours

BASED ON: academic performance and demonstrated community involvement, preferably with criminal justice. A letter of support is required from the community organization(s) with which the student is involved. Selection will conform to the University of Winnipeg Senate's Condition of Eligibility for Awards. Student enrolment status is as determined by the University of Winnipeg Senate. The Selection Committee will consist of the Department of Criminal Justice's Academic Awards Committee. **Students interested in the Skoog prize must be a Criminal Justice major, completed at least 60 credit hours (of which 18 must be in CJ designated courses) and submit their application form and letter(s) of agency support no later than September 15th to be considered for the annual award. Students must be enrolled in at least 18 credit hours in the upcoming academic year to be considered.**
