Applicants would preferably have a PhD in Anthropology at the time of appointment and expertise in applied anthropology with a geographic focus on the Americas. ABD candidates and other specializations will be considered. Salary levels will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.

The successful candidate will have experience teaching undergraduate courses and the ability to teach a combination of courses at all levels, including but not limited to: Introduction to Anthropology, Introduction to Cultural Anthropology, Method and Theory in Cultural Anthropology, Ethnography of North American First Peoples, and Ethnographic Research Methods.
