The ability to teach courses on abnormal behavior would be desirable. The Ph.D. degree is required. Applicants must be committed to teaching and have a demonstrated record of research productivity. Recent appointments to the Department have either arrived with grant funding or made successful applications in their first year. Subject to budgetary approval, the appointment will be effective July 1, 2012. Salary will be commensurate with qualifications and experience within the limits stipulated by the University's Collective Agreement.
