The Department of Economics, The University of Winnipeg, invites applications for one probationary tenure track appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor. Subject to budgetary approval, this appointment's commencement date is to be July 2012. Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience.

Applicants will hold or be near completing a PhD in Economics. Preference will be given to applicants in the fields of macroeconomics, international finance, monetary economics or finance, but strong applicants in other fields will be given consideration. The successful candidate must have a strong commitment to research and teaching.

In accordance with Canadian Immigration requirements, first preference must be given to Canadian citizens and permanent residents. The University of Winnipeg is committed to employment equity, welcomes diversity in the workplace, and encourages applications from all qualified individuals including women, members of visible minorities, aboriginal persons and persons with disabilities.
