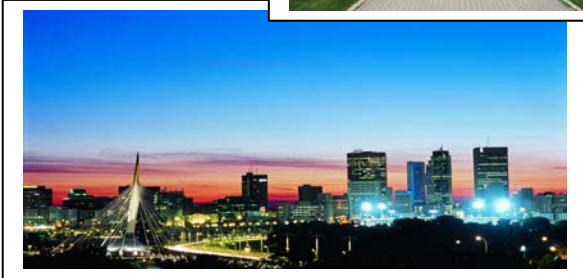




# THE UNIVERSITY OF WINNIPEG

### English Classes:

Participants will have the opportunity to improve their English through 30 hours of class time each week, in a small, personalized environment.

### Activities:

Furthermore, participants will experience many exciting attractions and events within Winnipeg and the surrounding area three nights each week, in addition to every Friday afternoon.

#### *Activities may include:*

- Visiting the Forks Market
- Watching a sporting event, such as the Winnipeg Goldeyes (baseball) or the Winnipeg Blue Bombers (football)
- Visiting the Museum of Man & Nature
- Taking a day trip to Lake Winnipeg, Gimli or Grand Beach
- Visiting Assiniboine Park and the Assiniboine Park Zoo

#### *Transportation:*

For trips out of Winnipeg, The University will arrange transportation. A monthly bus pass is required within the city, which is not included (in the tuition).

#### **Accommodation:**

Participants have two options for accommodations. They can stay with a carefully selected host family (\$600/month homestay + \$150 placement fee, all meals included).

**Tuition:** \$1450 + \$74 Health Insurance + Accommodations
