



# INTERNET SITE ADMINISTRATION DIPLOMA

## Part-Time Program

This course is aimed at individuals who need to have a thorough understanding of internet site “back end” technology and operating systems in order to host their own Web pages.

Implementation, administration and hardening of systems will be covered from many perspectives, giving students knowledge of how to configure, support and enable the information to be displayed on the World Wide Web.
