PAYMENT INFORMATION

Where and How Payable

- IN PERSON at Student Central (located in Centennial Hall at Lockhart Hall entrance on the Main Floor). Interac,. Students are cautioned against carrying large amounts of cash.
 - DROP-BOX Located on East wall across from Security Office, Centennial Hall. Cheques, money orders or certified cheques only, made payable to University of Winnipeg
 - BY MAIL to The University of Winnipeg, Accounting Office, 515 Portage Ave, Winnipeg MB, R3B 2E9 (**Must be received by due date**)
 - FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS AND WEB SERVICES - Telephone and On-line Payment Systems or by credit card using your U. of Wpg. Web Account
- . Payments can be made through via the Web Advisor link to your bank on-line payment systems**

Payment by Term

- Tuition fees, incidental fees, University of Winnipeg Students' Association fees, UWSA Health Plan fees and UWSA Building Fund fees are payable on the due dates for each term as stated on registration information available for each term. (See Student Health Plan Information for plan fees)

NOTE: Address Changes – Ensure address changes are made in the Student Records Office as they occur. Fees are due on time.
Students sponsored by an agency – Ensure an authorization has been submitted to the Accounting Office prior to fees being due.

PAYMENTS WITH AWARDS and/or STUDENT AID

- Students in receipt of Manitoba Student Loan and Canada Student Loan Certificates of Eligibility will have these forms endorsed by The University of Winnipeg Director of Awards and Financial Aid in the Awards and Financial Aid Office.
- Students in receipt of scholarships or bursaries from other than The University of Winnipeg should provide documentation to the University Awards and Financial Aid Office prior to registration or the applicable due date.
- Students who are paying fees by a Canada Student Loan which is not yet approved must make special arrangements with the University Awards and Financial Aid Office prior to the due date.

FAILURE TO PAY FEES

- Failure to pay fees when they are due may result in cancellation of the student's registration. (Registrations are cancelled in accordance with the *Withdrawal Schedule*). Students wishing reinstatement (if allowed) must pay all fees due, including re-registration fees and \$25.00 per course reinstatement fees (cash, Interac or certified cheque only).
- The same action may be taken when cheques in payment of student accounts are returned by the bank as non-negotiable, funds not cleared, account closed, etc.
- **Until all fees have been paid, grades will not be released and students will not be eligible for graduation or enrolment in subsequent terms.**

REFUND OF FEES

Students who withdraw from a course must follow the dates published on the *Withdrawal Schedule* for each term to be aware of how much credit, if any, will be applied to their account.

Students who withdraw from a course for medical reasons, or because they are moving from the province may receive partial refunds, called tuition fee credits for their fees paid. This includes refundable portions of tuition fees and University of Winnipeg Student Association fees.

If a student pays by term, any credit received for withdrawing from a course is applied to the remaining balance owed to the University, regardless of due date. Students paying fees by Award, Canada Student Loan, or by Sponsorship follow the rules and regulations of each particular area. Payments made by Credit Card will be refunded back to the Credit Card Account
