

LORRAINE LATREMOUILLE FELLOWSHIP APPLICATION

Value: \$500

Terms of Reference: The Lorraine Latremouille Fellowship is provided through a generous bequest from the estate of the late Lorraine Latremouille and is administered jointly by The University of Winnipeg and by Research and Education for Solutions to Violence and Abuse (RESOLVE). Applications for this fellowship are invited from University of Winnipeg students who will be registered in an undergraduate degree program during the current academic year and who will be conducting research in the area of family violence.

Applications will be reviewed by the University of Winnipeg Research Committee, and the fellowship will be awarded in two disbursements. The research must meet the criteria for sponsorship and affiliation by RESOLVE, and a copy of the final research report or thesis must be filed with RESOLVE. (A copy of RESOLVE's criteria is available through the Office of the Vice-President, Research and International, 4CM02, Library Mezzanine.

Documentation: Applicants should submit the following:

1. The information requested on this application;
2. your complete, official University of Winnipeg transcript;
3. a written description of your research plans (see below).
