Request for Documentation to Confirm the Diagnosis of a Disability/Medical Condition

Dear Certified Professional:

In order to facilitate appropriate and reasonable academic accommodations in the classroom, during tests and exams, and on campus in general, Accessibility Services (AS) requests that our office be provided with the following information:

1. A clear articulation of the individual's diagnosis, disability or medical condition.
2. Recommendations for academic accommodations appropriate for the post-secondary setting.
3. Prognosis (if temporary please provide a time frame that accommodations should be provided).
