

## APPLE LAPTOP CONFIGURATION: CONNECTING TO SECURE NETWORK For Students

Apple laptops equipped with AirPort are able to connect to the secure network of the University of Winnipeg.

You will need the following information for connecting to the secure network:

Network Name: UW-STUDENTS

Password: 22964kjinwer94773cgenu829321

STEP 1: Click on the Airport icon (see fig. 1) and select Other... from the menu, which will open the Closed Network window (see fig. 2)

**NOTE:** Requires web authentication. This means that even though the client has associated with the network and obtained an IP address, no network activity can occur until a web browser is opened. The web browser will automatically be redirected to an authentication page, where the user enters their Novell name and password. After that has happened, the user is free to use the network.

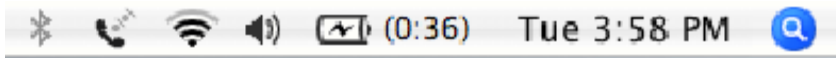

STEP 2: Type in the Network Name field “UW-STUDENTS” (without quotations, see fig. 3 on the next page)

STEP 3: Select from the dropdown box for Wireless Security “WPA Personal” (see fig. 3)

STEP 4: Type or copy and paste the following key into the Password field:

**22964kjinwer94773cgenu829321** (see fig. 3)
