## Language Courses

***Language courses will enrich your education, and many can be used to fulfill the University's Distribution and Humanities Requirements. The courses may be especially relevant if you have an interest in language learning for the purposes of cultural exposure, international travel and/or work, or contact with a core humanities area.***

The University of Winnipeg offers:

- The classical languages Greek and Latin through the Classics Department;
- Chinese, Classical Chinese and Japanese through the Department of East Asian Languages and Cultures;
- Cree and Ojibwe through the Department of Indigenous Studies;
- French, German, Italian and Spanish through the Department of Modern Languages and Literatures; and
- Arabic and Biblical Hebrew through the Department of Religion and Culture.

The University of Winnipeg's language courses provide up-to-date, effective instruction for beginners as well as intermediate to advanced students. These courses will enrich your education, and many can be used to fulfill the University's Distribution and Humanities Requirements (for details see under "Degree and Major Requirements" in the Course Calendar). Students from any degree program may choose to study a language as a part of their university studies. The courses may be especially relevant if you have an interest in language learning for the purposes of cultural exposure, international travel and/or work, or more specialized study in a particular field such as History, Religion, or Philosophy. In all of the courses, you will gain knowledge and competence in oral and written skills while learning to appreciate the richness and diversity of culture.

The following introductory courses are designed for students with little or no knowledge of the language:

EALC-1100(6) Introductory Japanese

IS-1101(6) Introductory Cree  
IS-1201(6) Introductory Ojibwe  
FREN-0002(3) Preparatory French  
FREN-1001(6) Introductory French  
GERM-1001(6) Introductory German  
ITAL-1001(6) Introductory Italian  
SPAN-1001(6) Introductory Spanish  
REL-2001(6) Elementary Biblical Hebrew  
REL-2010(6) Introduction to Modern Standard Arabic

If you are a native speaker or have Grade 12 (40S) standing in any of these languages, you are not permitted to take the introductory course. Students who already have some knowledge of the language should contact the Department in question to determine what course to begin with. You may be able to go directly into a higher-level course. For more information about courses in any of the languages listed above, visit the relevant Department's website, or consult the Course Calendar and the course offerings on WebAdvisor. Some language courses may

not be offered every term. Contact information for each Department is listed below.

### **REQUIRED HIGH SCHOOL COURSES**

You must meet The University of Winnipeg's general admission requirements. Introductory courses are designed for students who have never studied the languages. Consult the relevant Department for information on placement and for permission to enrol in the course for which you qualify.

### **HOW TO APPLY – Domestic Student**

### **HOW TO APPLY – International Student**

Apply online at [uwinnipeg.ca/index/intl-apply](http://uwinnipeg.ca/index/intl-apply) and submit all official documents by mail. To meet Scholarship deadline submit application, fee, and documents by **March 1st**. International application fee is \$100, which includes a one-time courier fee.
