Group III Cognate Courses

(minimum 18 credit hour/maximum 36 credit hours)

A total of 18 credit hours must be chosen from at most three of the following departments: Business and Administration, Biology, Chemistry, Geography, Physics, Mathematics and Statistics. Of these, 6 credit hours must be at the 2000 level or above. Students are strongly advised to consult the Chair or the 4-Year Advisor prior to taking any Group III courses.

Notes:

- Students are admitted to the BA 4-Year program after successful completion of 30 credit hours.
- Maximum Major and Cognate courses combined is 84 credit hours.
- Consult Course Calendar online for a list of courses in Group II.
- Students are encouraged to take more than 57 credit hours in Applied Computer Science.
- Students must meet with the Department Advisor when planning their studies.
- A minimum GPA of 3.0 (B) in the major courses is required to register for 4000 level courses.
- MATH-2305(3) & MATH-2901(3) cannot be used to meet the Math/Stats requirement.
- Pre Calculus or Applied Mathematics 40S is the prerequisite for MATH-1401(3) and all 1000-level Statistics courses.
- Combined Major prescribed courses:** ACS-1803(3), ACS-1903(3), ACS-1904(3), ACS-2906(3), ACS-2913(3) - refer to Calendar for more details

All students must fulfill the university Academic Writing Requirement by course work or exemption prior to enrolling in their 42nd credit hour. [RHET-1105(3) or RHET-1110(6)]

Distribution Requirement ☐

Students must complete at least 3 credit hours from at least 5 different departments.

Restriction in Introductory Courses ☐

No more than 42 credit hours below the 2000 level may be used for credit toward the degree. Of these, no more than 6 credit hours may be below the 1000 level.

Residence Requirement ☐

Minimum 60 credit hours must be taken at the U of W, a minimum 30 of which must be in the Major subject. 2nd degree students must complete a minimum of 30 credit hours at or above the 2000 level.

Academic Performance Requirement ☐

A C (2.0) Grade Point Average is required on those courses used towards fulfilling the Major requirements (effective Sept/88) and those used to fulfill the degree (120 credit hours.) Students with transfer credits must attain a C (2.0) Grade Point Average on those courses taken at the U of W that are to be used towards graduation.
