### Restriction in Introductory Courses

No more than 42 credit hours below the 2000 level may be used for credit toward the degree. Of these, no more than 6 credit hours may be below the 1000 level.

Residence Requirement ☐

Minimum 60 credit hours must be taken at the U of W, a minimum 30 of which must be in the Major subject. 2<sup>nd</sup> degree students must complete a minimum of 30 credit hours at or above the 2000 level.

**Academic Performance Requirement** ☐

A C (2.0) Grade Point Average is required on those courses used towards fulfilling the Major requirements (effective Sept/88) and those used to fulfill the degree (120 credit hours). Students with transfer credits must attain a C (2.0) Grade Point Average on those courses taken at the U of W that are to be used towards graduation.
