## Check the Course Calendar!

## Notes:

- Students must consult with the Program Advisor before declaring a major. Students should already have completed 30 credit hours.
- Only *one* of PHIL-1001/6, PHIL-1002/6, and PHIL-1301//6 may be counted towards a degree.
- Students in Year 1 of their studies are advised to begin their studies in Philosophy with one of the introductory courses.
- Most* 2000-level courses do not have pre-requisites.
- 3000 and 4000 level courses facilitate transition to an Honours program.
- 3000-level courses require a minimum of 12 credit hours in Philosophy.
- 4000-level courses require: A minimum of 15 credit hours in Philosophy (9 credit hours at the 2000-level or higher); B average or better in Philosophy courses; Permission of Program Advisor.
- Students are advised that 3000- and 4000-level courses are offered in rotation and may not be offered in each session.
