- Students must select a specialization in either a) Inclusion **OR** b) Child Care Administration. It is **STRONGLY ENCOURAGED** that students select their electives from the courses listed under each specialization. Please refer to Calendar online for a list of courses.
- Students selecting the Child Care Administration specialization should take **BUS-1201(3)** Introduction to Business I and **BUS-1202(3)** Introduction to Business II in their first year.
- Students are advised that most 2000-level and 3000-level courses require the prerequisite 1000-level Course in the Department concerned. Course prerequisites are detailed in the Calendar.

Academic Writing Requirement ☐

All students must fulfill the university Academic Writing Requirement by course work or exemption prior to enrolling in their 42nd credit hour.

Distribution Requirement ☐

Students must complete at least 3 credit hours from at least 5 different departments.

Restriction in Introductory Courses ☐

No more than 42 credit hours below the 2000 level may be used for credit toward the degree. Of these, no more than 6 credit hours may be below the 1000 level. Students receive block transfer credit for 30 credit hours. These are all considered to be at the 1000 level. Students can count no more than 12 credit hours below the 2000 level within the 60 credit hours required for the degree.

Residence Requirement ☐

Minimum 30 credit hours must be taken at the U of W, a minimum 18 of which must be in the Major subject. 2nd degree students must complete a minimum of 30 credit hours at or above the 2000 level.

Academic Performance Requirement ☐

A C (2.0) Grade Point Average is required on those courses used towards fulfilling the Major requirements (effective Sept/88) and those used to fulfill the degree (90 credit hours.) Students with transfer credits must attain a C (2.0) Grade Point Average on those courses taken at the U of W that are to be used towards graduation.
