- Students specializing in Child Care Administration should take **BUS-1201(3)** Introduction to Business I and **BUS-1202(3)** Introduction to Business II by the second year of their program.

- Students are advised that most 2000-level and 3000-level courses require the prerequisite 1000-level Course in the Department concerned. Course prerequisites are detailed in the Calendar.
- Students are advised to consult with the program coordinator in planning their curriculum.
- Students entering from high school are advised to take any first year Biology course, PSYC-1000(6), Academic Writing (if required), and Humanities requirements in the first year of their program

A C (2.0) Grade Point Average is required on those courses used towards fulfilling the Major requirements (effective Sept/88) and those used to fulfill the degree (90 credit hours.)
