 - all second-year courses(s) require the related first year theory courses(s) as their prerequisite.
 - all third year courses require the related second year theory course(s) as their prerequisite.
4. Students in the General program who are entering the third year of studies with a minimum 3.0 GPA (B) in all Economics courses may be permitted to register in maximum (two) 4000 -level courses with approval of Departmental Chair. A 4000-level course may be substituted for a 3000-level requirement.
5. Students entering their second year of study who have already completed 6 credit hours in Intro. Statistics may not use Statistical Analysis in Economics (ECON-2202/3) as credit towards a Major in Economics; these students need to take additional Economics course(s) in order to meet the minimum Major requirement.
