Notes:

- Admission Requirement:** Completion of 30 credit hours. Minimum GPA of 3.0 in Honours courses and 2.5 in non-Honours courses. This program is offered jointly with the Professional Program of the School of Contemporary Dancers; **entrance to the Professional Program of the School of Contemporary Dancers is by audition.** Once admission is obtained, students must also apply for admission to The University of Winnipeg; this must be done prior to registering for courses in the Dance Program Stream.
- Theatre and Film Stream courses cannot be used to fulfil the Honours subject requirements in the Dance Program Stream; they are considered to be a different subject with respect to the maximum number of courses permitted in the Honours subject and to the University Distribution Requirement.
- Where the sample course sequences suggested in the Course Calendar have not been followed precisely, students are encouraged to take Spring Dance Intensive courses or other optional courses to complete the degree. Please discuss possible choices with an Advisor.

Restriction in Introductory Courses ☐

No more than 42 credit hours below the 2000 level may be used for credit toward the degree. Of these, no more than 6 credit hours may be below the 1000 level.

Residence Requirement: ☐

Minimum 60 credit hours must be taken at the U of W, a minimum 30 of which must be in the Major subject including a minimum of 18 credit hours at the 3000 to 4000-level including a minimum of 9 credit hours at the 4000-level. 2nd degree students must complete a minimum of 30 credit hours at or above the 2000 level.

Academic Performance Requirement: ☐

A B (3.0) Grade Point Average is required on those courses used towards fulfilling the Major requirements and a C+ (2.5) Grade Point Average on all non-Honours courses. The minimum B (3.0) G.P.A. will be calculated based on all attempts, including course repeats and failures, in Honours Subject courses. The minimum C+ (2.5) G.P.A. in all non-Honours courses will be calculated as for a General Degree where failed courses are not included and in the case of repeat attempts, only the highest grade will be used.
