Only the Department Chair has the authority to grant prerequisite waivers.
- Admission to Applied Computer Science Courses:** Students are advised that a priority admission procedure may be used in the event that enrolments in Applied Computer Science courses are limited. For all courses, previous overall academic performance may be considered. For 2000-, 3000-, and 4000-level courses, grades achieved in prerequisite courses may also be considered.
- Only the Chair of the department has the authority to admit students to courses that are full.
- Priority for entry into **ACS-4901/6** will be given to students who require the course for graduation in the 4-Year degree program.
- Graduate Studies:** Students planning to continue with graduate studies are advised to consult with the Department before entering Year 2 of their studies.
- Course Substitutions:** Applied Computer Science courses were formerly numbered in the **32(MATH).xxxx** series and **92/91(BUSC).xxxx**. All courses with **32(MATH).xxxx** and **92/91(BUSC).xxxx** numbers may be substituted for corresponding **ACS-xxxx** numbers in meeting degree requirements.
