## INTRODUCTION

The University offers opportunities for work-integrated learning through cooperative work experiences, called Co-ops. Several Departments and Faculties have experiential learning courses and other opportunities established as courses within their own curricula. The University of Winnipeg's Co-operative Education Program is open to students with a declared Major in Applied Computer Science, Business and Administration, Economics, or Economics and Finance, though the program will consider students outside these areas on a case by case basis. The Co-op courses provide a university-wide means for Departments or Faculties to organize and recognize paid work terms as Co-op work terms for their students.
