As the highest honour presented by the University of Winnipeg Alumni Association, this award recognizes a member of our alumni community for outstanding achievement through personal and professional accomplishments and in contributions to the social, cultural, and economic well-being of society.

### Nomination Package

Your nomination package should include a completed copy of this nomination form, along with the following:

- (a) A minimum of two (2) letters of support and a maximum of four (4) letters of support
  - › Each letter of support must not exceed two (2) pages (if double-sided, must not exceed one (1) page)
  - › If additional letters of support are received, please include a list of individuals who have submitted letters. Additional letters may be included and will be kept on file.
- (b) Current résumé or curriculum vitae of the nominee

### Additional Eligibility Criteria

Graduates of The University of Winnipeg, The University of Winnipeg Collegiate, United College, Wesley College, and Professional, Applied and Continuing Education (formerly The University of Winnipeg Division of Continuing Education) diploma or certificate programs are considered alumni, and are therefore eligible for this award.

Sitting politicians, current faculty, staff, members of the Board of Regents, the Alumni Association Council, and individuals who have received an Honorary Degree from the University of Winnipeg are ineligible for this award. There are no provisions for a group award or a posthumous award.
