2000-LEVEL AND UP COURSES

- 3 yr ANTH majors require a minimum of 24 credit hours in ANTH at the 2000-level or above
- 4 yr ANTH majors require a minimum of 42 credit hours in ANTH at the 2000-level or above
- ANTH honours students require a minimum of 48 credit hours in ANTH at the 2000-level or above, of which 30 credit hours must be at the 3000 or 4000 level, with a minimum of 15 credit hours at the 4000 level.
- Students may qualify for Winter term courses that require a prerequisite by completing the prerequisite in Fall term (e.g. 1002 for 2108, etc.).

METHOD AND THEORY COURSES

- All minors, majors, and honours in Anthropology require 9 credit hours in Method & Theory, chosen from the following courses
- First year students may take ANTH-2200 and/or ANTH-2400 in the Winter term, provided that they complete the prerequisite (ANTH-1003 or ANTH-1002, respectively) in the Fall term.
