Section 1: Information and Requirements

Students enrolling in ANTH-4011(6), BANT-4011(6), or LING-4004(6) will undertake independent, original research as part of their Honours Thesis. Before registering for the course, students must:

1. Identify a faculty supervisor
2. Secure at least one second reader
3. Propose a tentative research topic

To lay the groundwork for a successful thesis, students are strongly encouraged to begin contacting potential supervisors and second readers as early as possible. Early conversations help ensure supervisor availability and allow time to refine project ideas.

Supervisor and Second Reader Requirements

Your Supervisor must be a full-time faculty member in the program in which you are completing your thesis.

If your Second Reader is from outside the program, please indicate their affiliation and provide their phone number(s) and email address(es) at the bottom of this page.

Ethics Approval

Some projects will require ethics approval. Please:

1. Review the policies at uwinnipeg.ca/research/research-ethics.html
2. Discuss requirements with your Supervisor as early as possible

To avoid delays, ethics applications should be submitted at the beginning of September. Failure to do so may result in a delayed thesis timeline.
