

## WHAT WE MAKE III: University of Winnipeg Virtual Community Art Exhibition Submission Guidelines

Online exhibit will begin mid-June 2020

- You are eligible to submit your artwork if you are:
  - A current UWinnipeg student (provide student number on submission form)
  - o A current or retired UWinnipeg staff or faculty member
  - A graduate of UWinnipeg
- Each participant may submit up to 2 works of art for the exhibition.
- All works of art must have been completed in the last 3 years.
- Works must be submitted in digital format as .jpeg files at 72 dpi and 1024x768 pixels. Submissions
  may include photography, painting, drawing, prints, textiles, sculptures, ceramics, etc. Unfortunately,
  we are unable to present video files at this time.
- Please remove any irrelevant backgrounds in digital images and ensure adequate image quality.
- Gallery 1C03 will be responsible for all curatorial decisions for the exhibition. Gallery 1C03 reserves the
  right to refuse artwork if it is deemed to be offensive (ie. racist, homophobic, etc) or if digital image
  quality is poor.
- Works will be on display on the gallery's website, blog, social media feeds and/or other online platform.
- To confirm your participation, <u>email</u> the information on the next page to Gallery 1C03 Director/Curator Jennifer Gibson no later than June 1, 2020. She will reply to confirm receipt and acceptance of your work.
- Gallery 1C03 is a public gallery and does not facilitate the sale or hire of artwork. We will, however, direct viewers to your website or social media feeds if you wish.
- We plan to launch the virtual exhibit in mid-June, but check back on our website or social media feeds for the exact date.

Submitting your entry via email indicates that you have read and will adhere to these guidelines.

Each participant may submit up to 2 works of art. Artist names and artwork titles, media, and year of production will be included with artworks published online. Where space permits, artist biographical information and artwork descriptions will also be included.

- Year(s) and department/faculty you have attended/worked at/graduated/retired from UWinnipeg.
- Up to 100 word artist biography include information about your artistic work in general and your connection to UWinnipeg and any other biographical information you feel may be of interest or pertinent to exhibit viewers.
- Digital files for up to 2 artworks in following format:
  - .jpeg
  - o 72 DPI
  - o 1024x768 pixels
- Artwork information for up to 2 artworks:
  - Titles
  - o Dates
  - Mediums
  - o Dimensions
  - Up to 200 words describing and/or discussing the context for your artworks. Can include information about how or why they were made or any other information you feel would be relevant to viewers.
- Artist contact information:
  - Indicate if you wish to give Gallery 1C03 permission to link to your artistic website or your social media feeds.
  - o If so, provide appropriate website link/social media handles.
- Gallery 1C03 is a public gallery and does not facilitate commercial activity. If we are contacted by someone wishing to purchase your work, we will send you the email address of the person who has made the inquiry.
- Gallery 1C03 reserves the right to edit artist biographies and artwork descriptions for length, grammar, and clarity.
