#### Budget

VP Admin Mike Emslie presented on the University budget. Questions were asked about ongoing cost of student residences, plans for a means test to ensure that students most affected by tuition increases received bursaries, and the force of mandate letters from the province.

A change in government will allow tuition costs to rise by 6.5%. UW is in the lowest third of tuition fees for universities across the country. Our graduation rates are low, and this reality could affect a budget that is becoming more dependent on tuition.

#### **Business Arising**
