The Transition Year Program exists to help all first year Aboriginal students – First Nation, Métis and Inuit – make the transition to university a successful one. Our goal is to prepare students for the academic rigors of university and to foster resilience in students to complete their chosen area of study.

All transition year students participate in a mandatory orientation day prior to the beginning of fall classes. Each new student is matched with a returning University of Winnipeg student mentor to assist in the adjustment to university life. The program coordinator also helps students in course selection, registration and on-going study skills sessions.
