



## The Marsha Hanen Award for Excellence in Creating Community Awareness Nomination Form

This award recognizes activities of faculty and staff, which create awareness of The University of Winnipeg in the external community, and reinforce the value of a liberal education and expand understanding of, and respect for, The University of Winnipeg. The purpose is to give recognition to those who have been innovative in developing or enhancing activities or programs which increase the awareness of the depth and breadth of expertise which exists on campus. The nominee must be a full-time employee at the University. The Hanen Award is traditionally given at the Fall Convocation ceremony.

### Nominations:

A completed nomination package includes the following:

- This completed *Nomination Form*
- 1-2 page nomination letter, to include:
  - the programs and activities the nominee has been involved in that raised the profile of the University;
  - the extent and period of time the nominee has been involved in these activities;
  - the skills and abilities the nominee has brought to these initiatives;
  - the impact on awareness provided to the University as a result of these initiatives; and
  - any other useful documentation or information that the Committee may find useful in understanding the full impact of the nominee's contributions.
- Up to 4 reference letters
- Up to 10 pages of supporting documents defining the nominee's contributions to creating community awareness, inclusive of attachments and appendices
