

FAQ regarding HBOMF 2016 award process

1. What is the deadline date for applications for 2016.

All applications must be received by 4:30 p.m. on December 8, 2016

2. I already filled out an application form, can I submit it?

No, the application forms have been revised and are on the website for download. Please use this version for the 2016 application process.

3. Do I need to submit a transcript from the Institution I attend? (They cost money)

No, you may submit a copy of the courses you are currently enrolled in from your webadvisor.

4. What if I am a part-time student, can I still apply?

No, the award is intended to support Indigenous students attending a Manitoba post-secondary Institute with a FULL-TIME COURSE LOAD FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR.

5. Can my references submit their letters of support to the Foundation directly.

No, all letters must be submitted with the application in order to be considered for adjudication.

6. Can I fax or email my application to the Foundation?

No, all applications must be mailed, couriered or dropped off to the address on the application. For further information, this location is a UPS store mailbox.

7. When will I be notified if I receive an award?

Notification of recipients will be posted to the website on December 12, 2016 at 4:00 P.M.

8. If I am a recipient, when will I receive the award?

It is anticipated that all awards will be mailed out on or before December 31, 2016.

9. If I am not an award recipient, can I appeal?

There is no appeal process. There is only a limited number of awards and the Foundation issues awards based on the amount of money that is available in any given year.

10. Who is the adjudication panel?

The panelists are members of the Indigenous community, elders, former recipients, academic institutions and funding partners.

11. How are applications adjudicated?

The adjudication panels only reviews fully completed applications. They are assessed on the strength of your story, your knowledge of Helen Betty Osborne and the issue of Missing and Murdered Women and girls, your statement on the calls to action. It is highly recommended that you let your passion for your academic choice and your commitment to community shine. Show your best self through your narrative!
