Awards Terminology

Scholarship

- Most recent academic performance (grade 12 grades)
- Community involvement, extra-curricular may be included

Bursary

- Financial need, awarded after classes begin
- Minimum 65% average (2.0 GPA)
- Expenses/resources declaration in online application

Award

- Grades and financial need
- Community involvement, extra-curricular may be included



Special Entrance Scholarships (SES)

- Complete admission application by March 1, 2022 = Automatically Eligible
- Conditional offer made with interim Grade 12 grades shortly after admission; final value confirmed in August with final Grade 12 grades.
- Average based on: English 40S + Math 40S + One other 40S full credit course
- Scholarship Values:

85.0-89.9% - \$1,100

90.0-94.9% - \$1,750

95.0%+ - \$2,250

• Special Entrance Scholarships can be deferred for one year (except B.Ed.)



Entrance Awards Requiring an Application

- 1. Deadline is March 1 but...
- 2. Apply for admission EARLY!! (earlier than March 1 deadline...)
- 2. Receive a uwinnipeg.ca student email account
- 3. Use your uwinnipeg.ca email to log-in to the online awards application

The online application will auto-match students to entrance awards

One online application = Access to all entrance awards being offered!

- Applications open mid-August, deadline Oct 1.
- Online awards application = back to school tasks every year
- Application is critical to be considered for bursaries/financial need-based awards

- Plan ahead, talk about money
- Get help from experienced, objective, and trained sources (UWinnipeg)
- Make studying the first priority for how you use your time each day/week

Government Student Aid

- Terminology: Government Ioan/grant, MB Student Aid, Canada Student Loan...
- Similar requirements/processes for all provinces and territories
- Perception: confusing, expensive, no one to help, suspicious of gov't...
- Reality: UWinnipeg are experts and love to help, website/online application is easy, loan amounts and repayment better than any bank, more grants/bursaries than ever before (free \$\$\$)

Best option if you aren't 100% financially supported while studying



Gov't Loans as Time Management

"I am going to work a job while studying, I don't need a loan"

- Student loans are more about time management than money
- 24 hrs x 7 days = 168 hrs per week: Is this enough time to work and study?
- 1 hour in class = 2 hours of study at home (reading, assignments, essays, research, lab work, etc.).
- 4 classes = 36 hours per week + 56 hrs sleeping + commute + eating +?
- Work less for tuition/living expenses = Study more (better grades, graduate sooner)



Government Student Aid

- 1 online application \rightarrow 2 funding sources: Provincial and Federal governments
- **Not just loans!** Application = non-repayable grants and bursaries
- Funding is based on need (resources vs. expenses)
- Parents/guardians, student savings/resources are considered in calculation
- Entire family situation is considered
- No interest and no payments while studying full-time
- Apply to see what is available to you with no commitment to take a loan!
- Visit UW Awards → Gov't Student Aid = video How Government Student Aid Works
