

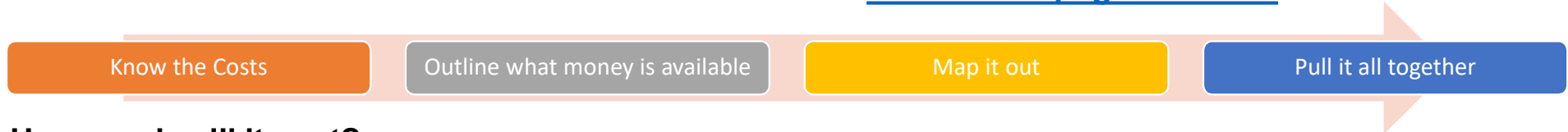

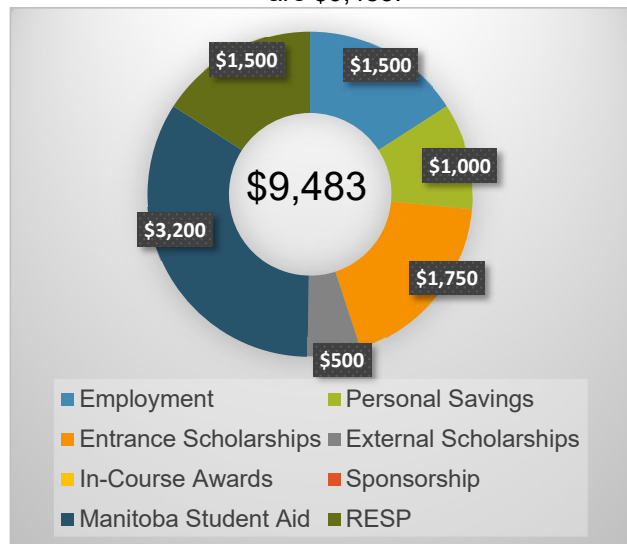
How much will it cost?

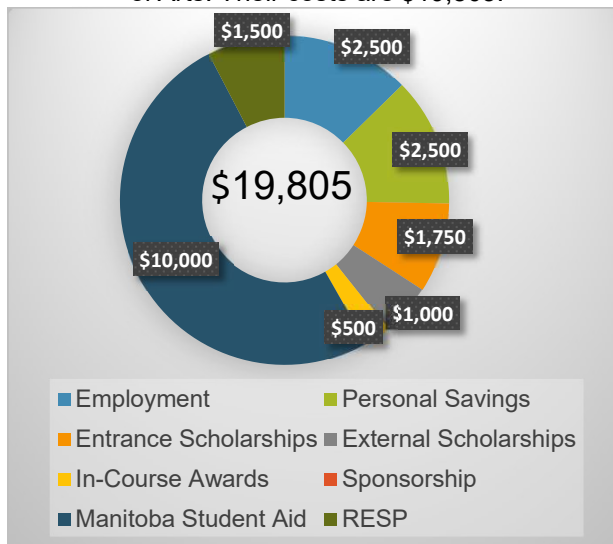

What Money is Available?

Student #1 is living with parents and is enrolled in the Faculty of Arts. Their costs are \$9,483.



Student #2 is living on campus in housing with a meal plan and enrolled in the Faculty of Arts. Their costs are \$19,805.



Student #3 is living away from home and enrolled in the Faculty of Arts. Their costs are \$16,843.



Helpful Tips

- Entrance Scholarships:
 - The University of Winnipeg offers both “Applied For” and “Automatic” Entrance Scholarships.
 - See our first year Awards and Financial Aid Guide.
- Employment:
 - Students can work and receive Manitoba Student Aid (MSA) at the same time.
 - Consider how many hours you will need to dedicate to courses
 - For each course you take, expect to spend up to 3 hours studying for every 1 hour of lecture..
- Manitoba Student Aid:
 - Provides more than just loans; many students qualify for bursaries and grants.
- Sponsorship can come from; First Nation Funding, Manitoba Metis Federation, Employers, Manitobans With Disabilities, and more.
