Requirements for transfer credit:

Red River College students completing the Full-time two-year Business Administration Diploma with an overall 'B' average (3.0 GPA) may be eligible to receive transfer credit, towards a University of Winnipeg Undergraduate Degree.

A minimum grade of 'C+' is required for all transferrable RRC courses. Transfer credits would receive grades of 'S' for Standing. The specific grade earned does not transfer.

There will be no retroactive transcript assessments processed after the application process has started; this will also apply to students previously assessed.

Any courses older than 5 years from the date of application will not be eligible for transfer credit into the University of Winnipeg.

Students should note that some BBA courses require the completion of high school course Pre-Calculus Mathematics 40S or Applied Mathematics 40S.
