Basic Admissions Requirements	To be considered for the Faculty of Graduate Studies, all applicants must present the following minimum requirements:
	<ul> <li>A four-year baccalaureate degree from Concordia University of Edmonton or its equivalent from a recognized institution. Individual graduate programs may recommend applicants as qualifying/probationary students (e.g., those with three-year degrees).</li> </ul>
	An admission grade point average (AGPA) of 3.0 (on Concordia University of Edmonton's 4-point scale) or equivalent on the most recent 60 credits of undergraduate (or graduate) study.
	Demonstrated fulfilment of the English Language Requirement.
	Individual graduate programs may impose additional admission requirements.
