Founded in 1978, Ross University School of Medicine offers a MD degree program. The Medical Sciences curriculum is delivered at our high tech campus in Barbados. This organ systems-based curriculum is designed to enable students to acquire and master basic sciences concepts and prepare to integrate knowledge of these concepts into clinical care. Clinical rotations are completed at affiliated US teaching hospitals. Ross University has an alumni network of 14,000+ MD's across Canada and the US; and offers scholarships for students who qualify. Students may be eligible for provincial student loans and/or professional lines of credit. Canadian student tuition is pegged at \$13,000 CAD/semester for the Medical Sciences semesters and paid in Canadian dollars. Canadian students receive free housing in their first semester and subsequent Medical Sciences semesters by maintaining a 2.65 GPA or higher.
