We provide **service centres** like Women Trans Spectrum Centre, Rainbow Lounge, UWSA Bike Lab, Access Lounge, and BIPoC Lounge for students to unwind and study in. We support **student initiatives** like the Indigenous Students Association, The Uniter, CKUW, and student groups and organize **events** like Roll Call and Snowed In that engage campus and community.

We are a registered non-profit with almost a 100 employees. We hold elections to elect students for four full-time executive postions and for the Board of Directors.
