We support **student initiatives** like the Indigenous Students Association, The Uniter, CKUW, and student groups and organize **events** like Roll Call and Snowed In that engage campus and community.

We are a registered non-profit with almost a 100 employees. We hold elections to elect students for four full-time executive positions and for the Board of Directors.
