



STEP Services is the official student employment placement service for the Government of Manitoba. Eligible students can find full and part-time jobs with government departments, agencies, and Crown corporations throughout the year in various locations across the province. The STEP Services program provides high school and post-secondary students with employment opportunities with the Government of Manitoba.

Am I Eligible?

Eligible high school and post-secondary students ages 16 and up can find full-time, part-time and co-op jobs throughout the year with government departments, agencies, and Crown Corporations throughout Manitoba. Eligible students must be 16 years of age or older on or before their first day of work and be enrolled in studies during the current academic year and returning to studies in the next academic year

When would I work?

Students are matched to job opportunities based on their work location, specific skills, field of study, and availability. Full-time jobs are available between May and August for post-secondary students and between July and August for high school students. Part-time jobs for post-secondary students are available from September to April, and co-op positions for students enrolled in Cooperative Education Programs can occur throughout the year.

What kind of jobs are available?

Students have the opportunity to work in a variety of fields within the public sector, with past jobs including: research assistants, day camp counsellors, engineering aides, groundskeepers, information technologists, clerical assistants, and trades helpers.
