### Tasks Include:

CSJ student will help evaluate the existing digital media supports and correct, update, delete and augment as needed.
- Research and review museology sources online and provide an annotated list of links for inclusion in digital communications and AMM website
- Contact all existing AMM members, verify their information, solicit web usable images and assist members in producing web-suitable images and assist members in producing web suitable descriptions of their museums and collections.
- Contact and reach out to museums that may not be AMM members to see if they wish to be included in the Musetoba (collections management database) project.
- Attend Regional Meetings with the AMM Communications Coordinator and/or the Executive Director to engage member museums in person.
- Visit at least three museums of different sizes and types to discuss digital access to collections.
- Participate in usability testing of new Musetoba website portal.
