



Position Posting – Industrial Hygiene Technologist

Duties include conducting industrial hygiene services including air monitoring and bulk sampling for hazardous substances, doing noise exposure surveys and preparing reports. The candidate should be mature, responsible, and adaptable to varying work environments and possess a strong pro-active work ethic. They should work well in a team environment and possess excellent communication skills. This is an entry position and training on all aspects of the job will be provided.

Major Responsibilities

- Scheduling inspections and surveys with clients
- Conducting field work for industrial hygiene monitoring (air sampling, noise dosimetry, etc.) and indoor air quality investigations
- Preparing sampling reports using standard templates
- Office work such as calibrating sampling pumps, obtaining media, submitting samples for laboratory analysis, collecting relevant data, and documenting events.
