Honorees

R.M. (Bob) Kozminski, BA, LLB Honorary Doctor of Laws

R.M. (Bob) Kozminski's reputation has been built on his business acumen as a principle player in the local automotive industry as well as his commitment to community through philanthropy and volunteerism with a particular interest in education, health and child safety.

Kozminski is proud of his roots as a Polish/Ukrainian growing up in Winnipeg's East Kildonan neighbourhood. From a young age he learned the importance education and hard work from his mother. After obtaining his Bachelor of Arts from The University of Winnipeg he continued his studies at the University of Manitoba where he obtained his law degree.

Kozminski maintained a very active law practice while his family company obtained the Budget Rent a Car/Truck franchise in Winnipeg. Kozminski later acquired Keystone Ford Sales in partnership with Ford Motor Company, at which point he decided to leave the practice of law. Over the years, Kozminski expanded his family business activities to include residential and commercial real estate development.

Although Kozminski is renowned for his keen business sense, his reputation as a philanthropist and his involvement in

community is legendary. He is known to lead by example, setting a high bar through his active service on many boards of local and national prominence.

Committed to his alma mater, Kozminski is a founding member and director of The University of Winnipeg Foundation. In 2004, he assumed the role and responsibilities of Campaign Chair for the *World of Opportunity Capital Campaign*, which successfully attracted more than \$130 million in campus development, endowment, program funding, scholarships and bursaries for the University of Winnipeg.

The University of Winnipeg is honoured to present Bob Kozminski with an Honorary Doctor of Laws for his leadership in business and philanthropy that benefit of all Canadians.



Hartley T. Richardson, CM, OM Honorary Doctor of Laws

Hartley T. Richardson is one of Manitoba's most distinguished citizens. Through his leadership in business, service to the community and philanthropy, Richardson has demonstrated an unparalleled commitment to the people of Manitoba and Canada, and to their social, cultural and economic well-being.

As President & CEO of James Richardson & Sons, Limited, a private, family-owned corporation involved in the international grain trade and agri-foods business, real estate, oil and gas development, financial services and investments, his leadership is outstanding.

Richardson's lengthy history of community service includes stints as chairperson of Winnipeg's United Way Campaign, CNIB's That All May Read Campaign and International Distinguished Entrepreneur Award (IDEA) dinner. His many other volunteer contributions include the Lester B. Pearson United World College, the Manitoba Theatre Centre Capital Campaign, the Manitoba Opera Association, and the St. Boniface Hospital Research Foundation.

Richardson is a strong friend of higher education in Manitoba. In 2006, he initiated the single-most ambitious

and significant capital project in the history of The University of Winnipeg – the development of the Richardson College for the Environment & Science Complex. The project was initiated by a generous \$3.5-million donation from the Richardson Firm, Family and Foundation – one of the largest private donations in UWinnipeg's history. This state-of-the-art science building now engages more than 2,000 students and faculty in innovative research and development in the natural and social sciences and has helped to revitalize the downtown and West End neighbourhoods.

Today, The University of Winnipeg is honoured to present Hartley Richardson with an Honorary Doctor of Laws for his leadership in business, service to the community, and lifelong commitment to our university, city, province and nation.





Diane McGifford, BA (Honours), MA, PhD Honorary Doctor of Sacred Letters

Diane McGifford is a tireless advocate for post-secondary educational opportunities in Manitoba, having shared her passion and insights as the longest serving Minister of Advanced Education in Canada.

McGifford was born in Manchester, England, and moved to Manitoba at a young age, where she grew up in a working class family in Fort Rouge. Her academic zeal was stoked at The University of Winnipeg, where she received a Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in 1970. She obtained a Master of Arts in 1974 and a PhD in English in 1979. McGifford worked as an English professor at the Universities of Saskatchewan, the Manitoba and Winnipeg.

McGifford’s political career spanned 16 years. She was first elected as an MLA in 1995. In 1999, McGifford was appointed to Premier Gary Doer’s first cabinet as the Minister of Culture, Heritage and Tourism. In 2001, she became the Manitoba’s first Minister of Advanced Education. During her many years in this role, McGifford made some of her most significant and lasting contributions to the province.

During her term as Advanced Education Minister, McGifford also promoted significant campus infrastructure renewal and oversaw the introduction of several important pieces of

legislation. She also worked hard to bring the University College of the North to fruition. She not only participated in, but chaired important international ministerial committees for UNESCO and the OECD. In 2009, McGifford was appointed Chair of the Council of Ministers of Education Canada.



An indefatigable champion of the transformative power of education, McGifford worked diligently to broaden the range of learners. As Advanced Education Minister, she not only introduced the \$9M Manitoba Bursary and the \$2M Manitoba Graduate Scholarship programs, but also established, “Bright Futures,” a suite of programs that bring community-based organizations and schools together designed to address student success and access to post-secondary education among traditionally marginalized and under-represented populations. McGifford has been a steadfast supporter of The University of Winnipeg’s Opportunity Fund.

After serving with distinction in the demanding and challenging position of Advanced Education Minister for many years, McGifford retired from politics in October 2011.

Lesley Sisler, BA (Honours), MA Fellow of United College

Lesley Sisler joined The University of Winnipeg in 1978 and quickly established herself as a dedicated educator, mentor and academic leader. She served as an instructor, counsellor and Assistant/Associate Dean of the Collegiate, and is herself a proud graduate of both the Collegiate and UWinnipeg.

Sisler has been called the memory and the conscience of the Collegiate. During her tenure as Associate Dean, she helped shape the Collegiate and was instrumental in creating the Mission Statement and Instructor’s Handbook. As an educator, she was so highly esteemed by her colleagues that she was nominated for and received the Prime Minister’s Teaching Excellence Award. She created several courses that are still offered: Women’s Studies, French, EAL Canadian History and Gender Politics.

She was also deeply involved in all aspects of the University and has served on Presidential, Senate, and University and Collegiate committees. Her professionalism and integrity was unmatched.

For her many years of dedicated service to both UWinnipeg and Collegiate students, faculty and staff, we honour Lesley Sisler as Fellow of United College.





Brian Keenan, BA, MA, PhD

Fellow of United College

Keenan has been a renowned teacher of Philosophy for more than thirty-five years, most of which was spent at UWinnipeg until his retirement in 2008. With his wonderful Socratic style, he attracted and engaged countless students, who founded an annual essay prize in his honour when he retired. He also received the Clifford Robson Distinguished Teacher Award in 2006. At the time, Bill Blaikie, MP, stood in the House of Commons to say "It was a well-deserved honour for someone who taught philosophy with insight, humour and relevance." It is with delight that UWinnipeg welcomed Keenan's return this year to teach one course on a contract basis.

Keenan's greatest joy is to foster debate. In his classroom, students talk as much as he does – they are dialogues, not lectures – discussions that continue out into the hallways. He is a tireless educator, arriving early, staying late, always accessible to his students and colleagues, and most notably, relentlessly full of good cheer.

Keenan grew up in Ontario where he attended Lakehead University, McMaster, and the University of Toronto before receiving a PhD in political philosophy from the University of Waterloo. Joining UWinnipeg in 1972, he spent a significant portion of this time acting as Chair of the Philosophy Department.

For his many years of dedicated service to UWinnipeg's students, faculty and staff, we honour Brian Keenan as Fellow of United College.



Steve Coppinger, BA

Fellow of United College

Steve Coppinger has dedicated time and energy to UWinnipeg for more than 45 years, and although now retired, he continues to serve the University with enthusiasm.

Coppinger first entered the doors of UWinnipeg as a teenager in 1967 as a Collegiate student. He would go on to earn a BA in Geography and as soon as he graduated, embarked on what would become a 36 year career at the University. For 18 of those years he was Associate Vice-President, Finance and Administration. His most marked characteristic continues to be his willingness to take on challenges and leadership positions that add value to the University, both as an employee and volunteer.

During his career Coppinger was involved in numerous campus activities, serving on the Board of Regents, Faculty and Staff Club, United Way campaign, UWinnipeg Interfaith Pastoral Institute and Western Canadian Pictorial Index. In 1994 his conscientious and diligent service was recognized with the Robin H. Farquhar Award for Excellence in Contributions to Self-Governance.

In retirement, Coppinger shifted his considerable energy to the University of Winnipeg Retirees Association and several committees of the University of Winnipeg Foundation. In

2010 he was an active and successful member of a small fundraising committee set up to create an endowed UWRA scholarship. The committee raised \$40,000 for an award that recognizes students who demonstrate strong academics and community service. He continues to fundraise for another potential bursary to assist students.

Outside the University Coppinger has been active in community life, as a soccer coach, Cub Scout leader, President of the Rotary Club of Winnipeg – Assiniboine, and volunteer at events such as the Pan Am Games. Today he attends many University events and is an ardent supporter of the Wesmen.

For his many years of dedicated service to UWinnipeg's students, faculty and staff, we honour Steve Coppinger as Fellow of United College.





Iain McDougall, MA, PhD

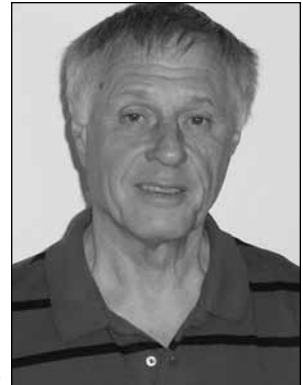
Professor Emeritus

The honour of **Professor Emeritus** will be conferred on retired Classics Professor, **Dr. Iain McDougall**. Dr. McDougall has earned this honour for his impressive contribution and impact on the Department of Classics during his 30 years of service to the University. His scholarship is nationally and internationally known and respected. Dr. McDougall has brought prestige to UWinnipeg and has created broad and lasting benefits to his students, colleagues and the discipline of Classics in general.

McDougall is renowned for being an excellent and dedicated teacher. An active researcher, McDougall's active scholarly activities led to numerous published articles in peer-reviewed Classics journals. One of his most impressive accomplishments is a two volume set on the *Lexicon of Diodorus Siculus*. The result of two decades of conscientious investigation, this 1700 page work is considered a highly valued research resource by scholars of classics worldwide. It resides in every major research library in the world.

Under Dr. McDougall's term as Chair of Classics, the department gained the reputation as being among the best undergraduate Classics department in Canada. In addition to his usual teaching load, his mentorship created many award winning students that earned Classic Awards within and outside the campus.

In 1992, he was awarded the Dr. Robin Farquhar Award for Excellence Contributing to Self-Governance in recognition for his many years of exceptional service on several committees, including the Board of Regents.



Dr. Jennifer S. H. Brown, BA, MA, PhD, FRSC

Professor Emeritus

Retired History Professor, Director of the Centre for Rupert's Land Studies and distinguished ethnohistorian, **Dr. Jennifer S. H. Brown**, has earned the rank of **Professor Emeritus**.

Dr. Brown's committed service to The University of Winnipeg is matched only by her impact on her field of study. Her publications have shed light on familial and social relations among fur traders and Aboriginal communities across three centuries. Her work also tackles the complex and multiple origins of people of mixed descent whose life trajectories led them towards diverse identities, Métis and other. By bringing together documentary and oral records generated from various perspectives, Dr. Brown has helped to preserve, develop and disseminate Aboriginal historical education. This work has not only advanced research in her field but has also increased the understanding of Aboriginal communities, histories and cultures among a wider audience.

These scholarly contributions are nationally recognized. Dr. Brown has held a prestigious Tier 1 Canada Research Chair (Aboriginal Peoples in an Urban and Regional Context), among numerous other honours and awards. Dr. Brown has also been elected a Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada, Academy II (Social Sciences), the highest honour for scholarship in Canada. As the Director of the Centre for Rupert's Land Studies, Brown fostered greater cooperation between scholars, the public and First Nations communities.





Ken McCluskey, BA (Honours), MA, PhD

Robin H. Farquhar Award for Excellence in Contributing to Self-Governance

Ken McCluskey, Dean and Professor of Education at UWinnipeg, is known internationally for his work in the fields of mentoring, gifted education and at-risk children and youth. Before becoming a Professor in 1998, McCluskey spent 25 years as a psychologist, special educator, and administrator in the public school system.

Those who know McCluskey describe his leadership style as unconventional, creative, and innovative, inspiring deep loyalty. He has tirelessly strengthened UWinnipeg's Faculty of Education internally and around the world. Under McCluskey's leadership UWinnipeg has become a leader in mentoring and community outreach, with programs such as Lost Prizes now piloted internationally. The faculty developed the Community-based Aboriginal Teacher Education program, a Post-Baccalaureate Diploma in Education, and headquartered the World Council for Gifted and Talented Children on our campus. Perhaps most telling is the response from students. In one decade the Faculty of Education has tripled from 600 to 1,805 students today.

McCluskey has received numerous awards, among the most recent: Spirit of Crazy Horse Award, Reclaiming

Clifford J. Robson Memorial Award for Excellence in Teaching

Dr. Failer is persistently described by her students as an outstanding professor. Among the top educators in her generation, she has earned one of the University of Winnipeg's highest honours.

Melanie Martin, BSc, MSc, PhD

The Erica and Arnold Rogers Award For Excellence In Research

When it comes to relevant research in the area of neurological disorders, UWinnipeg's Associate Professor of Physics, **Dr. Melanie Martin** stands out for her distinguished work. Currently, Dr. Martin is developing state-of-the-art, accurate, magnetic resonance imaging techniques for identifying and quantifying the physical effects of debilitating central nervous diseases (i.e. multiple sclerosis and Alzheimer's).

Dr. Martin obtained her graduate degrees at Yale University, where she was the first PhD graduate from Yale's Biomedical Engineering program. While at Yale, Dr. Martin also held the prestigious Pierre Hoge fellowship.

Undeniably, Martin is one of the University's top grant-supported researchers. She has held numerous Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council (NSERC) grants, including the University's first million dollar Canadian Foundation for Innovation (CFI) grant and an operating grant from the Manitoba Research and Infrastructure Fund. She has also received grants from the Canadian Institutes for Health Research, the Health Sciences Centre, the Heart and Stroke Foundation and the Manitoba Medical Services Foundation.

She is well regarded by the 23 scientific personnel in her research program with whom she has worked and mentored

the last six years. Experts in a variety of fields are attracted to her research (including Dr. Xin-Min Li, an expert in Psychiatry and a leader in expanding neurosciences research in Manitoba).



Dr. Martin is internationally respected in her field. She serves on several prestigious international scientific boards and committees. She has established international collaborations with Southeast University (China), the Institute of Mental Health at Peking University (China), University of Manitoba, Memorial University, University of Ottawa, University of British Columbia, University of Toronto, University of Saskatchewan, McGill University, Caltech, and St. Boniface Research Centre, and Winnipeg's National Research Council.

Dr. Melanie Martin encompasses the spirit of **The Erica and Arnold Rogers Award for Excellence in Research**. Her contributions have greatly enhanced UWinnipeg's reputation in excellence in research and scholarship.

Caleigh Christie, BSc (Hons) Geography, 2012

2012 Campus Sustainability Recognition Awards

During her time at UWinnipeg, Caleigh Christie has acted as the Co-President of the Geography and Environmental Studies Students' Association, the UWSA Bike Lab Coordinator, and as a member of the Environmental Studies Department Advisory Committee. Known for her humour, warmth, and intelligence, Christie continues to set the bar in student leadership, vision and advocacy.

Since 2010, Caleigh played a key role in the envisioning, fundraising and administering the EcoPIA/GESA EcoGrant. This is the first time the grant was awarded to support the development of a sustainability-focused student submission to the University's Strategic Review process that brought a strong student voice to the University's Strategic Review process.

Christie is a core member of the UWSA Ice Riders Bike Gang, the winter cycling team that is the spirit and energy behind the UWSA Bike Lab. She was one of four students who created a short film documenting the group's aspirations for an all-season cycling repair and advocacy centre.

Christie has represented UWinnipeg at several sustainable gatherings, including the Power Shift National Youth Gathering in Ottawa. She will represent the UWSA with two other colleagues at the international **Velo-city Global**, the world's premier international cycling planning conference in Vancouver, BC this summer. She also organized several awareness building campaigns related to climate change including the lead up to the 2010 climate talks, *Bringing Copenhagen Home*.



Christie has left her mark at The University of Winnipeg by advancing sustainable transportation on campus. She has increased awareness in innovative sustainability projects – encouraging others – young and old – to redouble their sustainability efforts.



Susan A. Thompson, BA

The Distinguished Alumni Award

Community leader, entrepreneur, politician, diplomat, philanthropic fundraiser and proud lifetime *Sponsor of HMCS WINNIPEG*, Susan Thompson is a trailblazer and an inspiration to women everywhere.

She was the first woman to own her family business, the first woman Rotarian in Manitoba, the first woman Mayor of Winnipeg and the first woman Consul General at the Canadian Consulate in Minneapolis.

A graduate of the University of Winnipeg Collegiate (Class of '67) and the University of Winnipeg (Class of '71), Susan enjoyed a successful retail career as international buyer with Eaton's and The Bay. In 1980, she purchased the family business from her father serving as owner and president of Birt Saddlery for 15 years. Elected Mayor of Winnipeg for two terms in 1992 and 1995, Susan led the City of Winnipeg through the largest crisis the city had faced in 100 years, known as the 'Flood of the Century' over 21 days in the spring of 1997.

Susan led successful bids for the 1999 Pan American games; the 1998 Canadian Briar Curling Championship; the 1998 World Junior Hockey Championship; the 1998 Grey Cup; the 2001 World Indigenous Games; and the 1995 Winter Cities International Conference.

In 1999, as Canadian Consul General in Minneapolis, Susan served an eight-state territory consisting of 15 million people and \$32 billion in Canada-US trade.

She returned to Winnipeg in 2003 to assume the role as founding President &

CEO of The University of Winnipeg Foundation. Together with the extraordinary commitment of Foundation Board members and staff, she managed an unprecedented \$38 million Endowment Fund and provided stewardship to over 7,600 donors. On September 16, 2011, just prior to Susan's retirement, the Foundation concluded the largest fundraising campaign in the University's history. Over \$135 million dollars (nearly double the original campaign goal of \$70 million) was raised in the 'A World of Opportunity Capital Campaign' in support of student awards, capital projects and academic enhancements.

A well-known and highly regarded leader, Susan Thompson is a woman of passion, a strong proponent of achieving the impossible and someone who believes in reaching for her dreams.

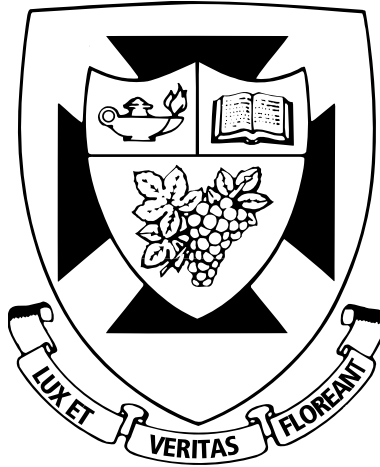

The University of Winnipeg Coat of Arms

The Coat of Arms of The University of Winnipeg was officially adopted by the governing bodies of the University during the academic session of 1972-73. The elements found within the Coat of Arms have been associated over the years with both Manitoba and Wesley Colleges, the ancestors of United College. The bunch of grapes in the lower portion of the inner shield derives from the Coat of Arms of Manitoba College. The grape symbol has its origin in the College seal adopted in the charter of 1871. The cross, the lamp, and the open book derive from the Coat of Arms of Wesley College, designed in 1897 by Dr. J.H. Riddell. The cross, the symbol of sacrificial service in the interest of humanity, was the basis for his design and upon it he placed a shield, the symbol of protection. The lamp, the symbol of light, also represents learning, to which the Colleges have been devoted to for over a century in the Province of Manitoba. The open book, representing instruction in the way of life and the bringing of understanding to the student, symbolizes knowledge in a general sense, although it may carry overtones of the Holy Scriptures in a more limited interpretation.

The motto, placed upon a scroll below, is the United College motto, her retained: Lux et Veritas Floreant (Let Light and Truth Flourish). The words catch the central import of the lamp (light) and the open book (truth), and express the hope that both may flourish (as the grape) in our country (the cross).



Academic Dress

Academic dress originated in medieval times to provide warmth in the damp halls of learning. In its present form it includes a gown, hood (worn over the shoulders), and a cap or mortarboard. All universities have distinctive dress for each degree offered which explains the variety seen in the academic procession.

University of Winnipeg academic dress conforms to the North American Intercollegiate Code. All graduates wear a black gown which varies according to the degree conferred. The bachelor's gown is worn closed in front and is distinguished by its pointed sleeves. The master's gown is designed to be worn either open or closed in front and has closed sleeves with an opening to free the hands. The front portion of the sleeve below the opening has a long semi-circular cut-out. Doctorate gowns also may be worn open or closed. They are faced with velvet.

The edging colour on the hood indicates the faculty in which a degree is conferred: Theology – red; Science – gold; Education – blue; Arts – white. The width of edging is determined by the degree: three inches for doctors; two inches for masters and bachelors. Hoods are lined in red with a white chevron.

Honorary doctors' gowns are red in colour and are faced with white velvet. They are worn with red Tudor bonnets. The hood colour signifies the honorary degree: white for Laws; golden yellow for Science; admiralty blue for Letters; purple for Divinity. Hoods are lined in red and white, The University of Winnipeg colours. Fellows wear a gown of blue with neither hat nor hood. Members of the University's senior administration wear gowns of varying colours. They do not wear hoods.

The Banner

The banner, prominently displaying the Coat of Arms, was unveiled in 1988. The volunteer effort of Pat Corner, Fran Farquhar, Susan Ferguson, and Sonya C. Wright took more than 1,000 hours. Over 400 meters of thread and 30 meters of wool material went into the project using traditional techniques such as quilting, embroidery, and crewel.
