The **Department of Kinesiology and Applied Health** is looking for a Study Hall Tutor through the Work Study Program starting in October. Deadline to apply is **September 29, 2017**. You must be approved through Awards and Financial Aid before applying for this position.

Hours and Schedule are flexible. You must meet the qualifications below.

Job Description:

The Study Hall Tutor will lead student study sessions for all students taking a course from the Kinesiology and Applied Health department who require teaching resources to study or practice their applied techniques. The project will provide the student with and an opportunity to tutor other students in a wide variety of Kinesiology related courses including Human Anatomy, Exercise Physiology, Biomechanics, Prevention and Care of Athletic Injuries, Sport First Responder, Assessment and Rehabilitation techniques, Taping techniques etc.

Tasks will include: a) Supervising student in a lab on a scheduled basis during the day; b) Maintain an inventory of teaching resources pertinent to the student needs c) Maintain a record of attendance for open study sessions; d) Provide mentorship and tutoring to students needing assistance with studying and practical application of the course work.

Qualifications:

Works well unsupervised; Good oral and written skills; Computer skills including Microsoft Word and Publisher; Grade of B or greater in at least 4 of the following courses: Human Anatomy; Prevention and Care of Athletic Injuries; Rehabilitation of Upper and Lower Limb Athletic Injuries; Massage Techniques; Advance Taping Techniques; Biomechanics, Exercise Physiology
