Enhanced Major Requirements

1. Course Assessment

Successful completion of the prescribed 60 credits hours. Students who have not completed all 60 credit hours may still apply but will be deducted points for incomplete credit hours.

2. GPA

Students must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 with a regular status admission. Students who have not met the regular status requirement may still be considered on a case by case basis.

3. Experience and Abilities

Students must submit a CV or resume and indicate their previous university/college experience as well as other skills that are relevant to a career in athletic therapy.

Examples:

- Work and/or volunteer experience – must include start and end date.
- Professional related skills (i.e. computer, leadership, interpersonal, writing, etc.)
- Certifications/Memberships (i.e. CPR-HCP, First Aid, CATA, etc.)

4. Personal Submission (Maximum 800 words)

Must include a rationale for choosing to pursue Athletic Therapy and that the student understands what the profession entails.

5. Faculty Recommendation/Reference Letter

Current University of Winnipeg students must submit the name of a faculty member from the Department of Kinesiology and Applied Health who recommends the student for the program (*Students must confirm this with the faculty member prior to listing them*).

Transfer students must arrange to send:

- A transcript listing completed courses and grades from the student's previous institution.
- A letter of reference from a faculty member from the student's previous institution. The letter must address the student's academic ability, potential for success in the Athletic Therapy program and profession, reliability, punctuality, and other relevant professional qualities. The letter of reference must be personally submitted by the faculty member by email or mail. Letters submitted by students will not be accepted. Please have the letters submitted no later than **April 1, 2019**.
