## Enhanced Major Requirements

### 1. Course Assessment

Successful completion of the prescribed 60 credits hours (<https://www.uwinnipeg.ca/dept-kinesiology/degrees/4-yr-bsc-athletictherapy.html>).

### 2. GPA

Students must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 with a regular status admission. Students who have not met the regular status requirement may still be considered on a case by case basis.

Transfer students must arrange to send:

- A transcript listing completed courses and grades from the student's previous institution.

### 3. Experience and Abilities

Students must submit a CV or resume and indicate their previous university/college experience as well as other skills that are relevant to a career in athletic therapy.

#### Examples:

- Work and/or volunteer experience – must include start and end date.
- Professional related skills (i.e. computer, leadership, interpersonal, writing, etc.)
- Certifications/Memberships (i.e. CPR-HCP, First Aid, CATA, etc.)

### 4. Personal Submission (Maximum 800 words)

Students must indicate in their personal submission letter why they want to pursue athletic therapy. They should also indicate that they have investigated the profession of Athletic Therapy. This may include interviewing/observing/shadowing an AT in their workplace; volunteering in sport first aid with a sport team under the supervision of an AT at a university/college or other level as well as other skills that may be relevant to a career in athletic therapy.

### 5. Professional Recommendation Letter

A professional letter of reference from a previous employer, practicum supervisor, etc. The letter must address the student's potential for success in the Athletic Therapy program and profession, reliability, maturity, and other relevant professional qualities. The letter of reference must be personally submitted by the referee by email or mail. Letters submitted by students will not be accepted. Please have the letters submitted no later than **April 1** of the intake year.
