



Athletic Therapy Program

Changes:

As of March, 2019, all students planning to pursue the 4 year BSc - Athletic Therapy degree must submit an **Enhanced Major Form** after successful completion of 60 credit hours of prescribed courses (2 years of full-time study).

Space in the Athletic Therapy program is limited and not all eligible students may be admitted.

A) NEW students applying to the University of Winnipeg

1) Students interested in pursuing Athletic Therapy will first apply to the University of Winnipeg through the online application.

Recommended High School Pre-Requisites:
Pre-Calculus 40S or Applied Mathematics 40S

2) When choosing a major on the online application, students should select the 4-year Bachelor of Kinesiology.

3) Once accepted to the University of Winnipeg, students should complete the following 60 credit hours of courses *prior to* completing the Enhanced Major Form:

4) The Enhanced Major Form must be submitted by **April 1, 2019**, for Fall



admission. Required courses should be completed prior to the April 1 deadline. Courses in the Winter 2019 term are eligible, but Spring/Summer 2019 are not. Once admitted to the Athletic Therapy program students will change their major to the 4 year BSc - Athletic Therapy. Students who do not receive admittance to the Athletic Therapy program are free to change their major.

Completion of the Athletic Therapy program can only be pursued on a full-time basis.

B) Transfer Students

Students seeking admittance to the Athletic Therapy program for a September start should **apply to the University of Winnipeg** prior to the end of January of the same year.

2) When choosing a major on the online application, students should select the 4-year Bachelor of Kinesiology.

Admission to the University of Winnipeg does not guarantee admission to the Athletic Therapy program.

3) After submission of all necessary documents to the University of Winnipeg admissions department course equivalency will be evaluated. Please be aware only up to 60 credit hours of equivalent courses may be transferred from other post-secondary institutions.

4) After receipt of the list of transfer credits, students must check which credit hours match the list of 60 credit hours of prescribed courses (see section A-3).

5) Submit the Enhanced Major Form if credit is received for most of the prescribed 60 credit hours.

Previous practical experience is considered in the admissions process but is not credited towards the practical hours required in the program.

C) Enhanced Major Requirements

The deadline to apply to the Athletic Therapy program for September, 2019 admission, is **April 1, 2019**. Enhanced Major Forms received after this deadline may be considered at the discretion of the Athletic Therapy program director.

1. **Course Assessment** - Successful completion of the prescribed 60 credits



hours (see A-3). Students who have not completed all 60 credit hours may still apply but will be deducted points for every 3 credit hours not completed.

2. **GPA** - Minimum GPA of 3.0 with a regular status admission. Students who have not met the regular status requirement may still be considered on a case by case basis.

3. **Experience and Abilities** - Students must indicate their previous university/college experience as well as other skills that are relevant to a career in athletic therapy.

4. **Personal Submission** - Students must indicate in the personal submission why they want to become an Athletic Therapist and what the profession entails.

5. **Faculty Recommendation/Reference Letter** - Current University of Winnipeg students must submit the name of a supporting faculty member. Transfer students must submit 1 academic reference letter.

6. **Valid certification** - Standard First Aid - Red Cross or equivalent, and Basic Life Support must be completed prior to beginning classes in the Athletic Therapy program.
