# **Program Policies**

## **Deferral Policy:**

- If you wish to transfer to another term, ELP must receive written notice of deferral at least two weeks before the program start date. You can only defer twice and will be charged a \$100 administrative fee per deferral.

- If you wish to transfer your homestay to another term, the Homestay Program must receive written notice of deferral at least two weeks before the program start date. You can only defer twice and will be charged a \$100 administrative fee per deferral.

## Late Registration and Refund Policy:

- The application fee and tuition deposit are non-refundable.
- The tuition fee is non-refundable after the application deadline which is two weeks before the program start date.
- A \$100 late registration fee will apply after the application deadline.
- The tuition fee is refundable if you wish to withdraw voluntarily before the deadline which is two weeks before the program start date. To receive a refund, ELP must receive written notice at least two weeks before the program start date. You will be charged a \$250 administrative fee.
