<b>Beginner: Starting in English</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>o Students will learn reading, writing, speaking and listening skills for everyday purposes.</li><li>o This course also focuses on grammar, pronunciation and vocabulary.</li></ul>
<b>Intermediate: Developing in English</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>o Students will develop their reading, writing, speaking and listening skills for academic and workplace purposes.</li><li>o This course also focuses on grammar, pronunciation and vocabulary.</li></ul>
<b>Advanced: Preparing for Academic English</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>o This course will introduce the academic reading, writing, speaking and listening skills required for university and college. This course also focuses on academic vocabulary and advanced grammar.</li><li>o Students who complete this course may be interested in taking English for Academic Writing and English for Speaking and Learning in the Part-time Program.</li></ul>
<b>Advanced: Enhancing Workplace English</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>o This course is for students who would like to resume or advance in their careers in Manitoba. Students will learn reading, writing, speaking, listening and intercultural communication skills needed for the professional workplace.</li><li>o Students who complete this course may be interested in taking English for Business Professionals and Speaking and Pronunciation.</li></ul>
