Hello and welcome to Riipen! We're excited that you've chosen to join our community of educators and organizations in order to facilitate work-integrated learning experiences for your students. Your experience will consist of three main segments:

- 1. Before Matchmaking
- 2. During Matchmaking
- 3. After Matchmaking

Like any fruitful relationship, there are things you can do to set up for success at each stage. So let's dive in!

Before Matchmaking

- Book a Riipen Matchmaking Session to go through these next steps:
 - Sign up to your school portal on Riipen (our team will send you a special link to join your school portal)
 - Create your course/internship page
 - Click the "Create Course" button on your <u>Dashboard</u> (or click "Create Internship Program" from your <u>Internships Program</u> page). Here you'll see the option to create a page from scratch, use a template, or duplicate a page you've created in the past.
 - Follow the step-by-step wizard to post the page. (Click "Exit" to save your work as a Draft on any step of the wizard)
 - If this is your first time on Riipen our onboarding team will also be there to help you with creating a draft and initial matchmaking

During Matchmaking

All of your courses and internships can be accessed from your <u>Dashboard</u>. You can access this at any time by clicking on your own initials/profile photo in the top right. Here are some key icons:



<u>Bookmarks</u> - Find pages you've bookmarked



<u>Messages</u> - Send and receive messages from organizations and students. Respond to requests.



Requests - Manage project requests and check their status



Help Centre (located on the bottom right) - the quickest way to reach our team if you have any questions or technical issues. From here you can access our live chat and find a collection of resources.



<u>Notifications</u> - Get notified of any new activity on your account



- Once your course/internship page is posted, you can connect with organizations by:
 - Requesting project from your <u>Bookmarks</u> and the <u>Project Library</u>
 - Click 'Request Project' on the top right corner of a Project page to initiate the request
 - Tip: Send at least 3 requests for every 1 project you want
- Using your Riipen page to promote your course/internship and invite partners from your own network to join
- Responding to organizations that requested to connect with you within 2 business days


After Matchmaking

1. Before the project begins, you want to invite your students to join your course/internship page. This will help students make the most out of their Riipen experience. There are a few ways to do this:

Option 2: Inviting Students to Teams

You can invite students to projects and form their teams. Click "Create Team" from the "Projects" tab of your course/internship page to invite students into teams by email addresses.
