How to make the best of your learning style



"Be stubborn about your goals and flexible about your methods." –Unknown Some flexibility in learning is necessary, but keep your goals consistent.

Our brains are all different, so not everyone remembers things in the same way. There are many different learning styles, and knowing which one you fall under can guide you in

developing the right tools and tactics to enhance your memory and understanding. Here are the four more common learning styles: The Visual Learner, The Auditory Learner, The Read and Write Learner, and The Kinaesthetic Learner.

If you're a visual learner, then you remember information better if it's in a visual form. Think about videos, images and demonstrations. Mapping is another way to do word or fact association by drawing a diagram, perhaps of circles and lines that connect to each other.

The auditory learner is able to remember better through hearing, like in a lecture or recording or even through talking through a concept. Tutoring or leading a study group would be a great way for an auditory learner to remember and recall.

The Read and Write Learner learns through note taking and much like the auditory learner whereby the kinaesthetic learner is a hands-on person. They learn by creating something almost 3D, like in building a model, or being able to physically piece things together like in the dice in the above caption.
