Either way, give yourself a pat on the back for starting that climb to the top in your future career by enrolling in post-secondary and working towards your degree! Once you've applied and been accepted into Co-op (applications due by October 1st, 2019), our Co-operative Education Coordinator, Jessica Adkin, will take you through the training that includes effective resume building, expert cover letter writing, interview skills and much more.

In addition, Co-op students have access to numerous networking events that place students face-to-face with hiring managers and industry leaders from every field, and posts hundreds of Co-op jobs. These are professional jobs (most located here but also throughout Canada, and Internationally) and ONLY available to Co-op students.

Co-op students are free to apply to the jobs that are a fit within their stream and may have the option of taking Co-op for credit, or not-for-credit! Several Co-op students have a job post-graduation from an industry they worked for as a Co-op student.

We know how tough the competition is post-graduation, but with a solid education AND work experience, you'll leave the competition dangling near the bottom of the hill.

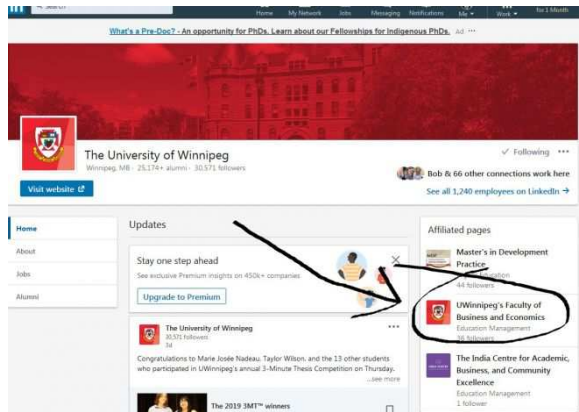
