The program

- Students with 60 to 87 credit hours will be eligible for a \$2,500 Tuition Scholarship and \$1,000 to cover education expenses
- Students with 90 or more credit hours and a preferred graduation date in Spring will receive a full tuition scholarship (up to \$5,000) plus \$1,000 to cover educational expenses
- Paid summer work term (May August)
- Employment support upon graduation

Eligibility

- Must be a full-time student
- Must have completed 60 credit hours
- Must have a declared major in either Business and Administration, Economics or Economics and Finance
- Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA
